George William Tither Past Grand Master Passes



GEORGE WILLIAM TITHER June 14, 1919 – February 9, 2014

George William Tither, P.G.M. To the Officers and Brethren of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of Kentucky, Free and Accepted Masons and its constituent lodges, and to all Masons to whom these presents may come, this sorrowful greeting:

It is with profound sorrow that I officially announce to you the passing of our beloved Past Grand Master

GEORGE W. TITHER

Brother Tither entered upon eternal rest Sunday, February 9, 2014, at the Christ Hospital Palliative Care Center in Cincinnati, Ohio.

The Masonic Services were conducted at Alexandria Funeral Home, 325 Washington St, Alexandria, Kentucky, Friday, February 14, 2014 at 7:00 PM by the Officers and Brethren of Fort Thomas Lodge No. 808, F. & A. M. Brother James Scott, P.M. (808) conducted the Masonic Funeral Rites as Acting Master of Fort Thomas Lodge No. 808. Many other Masonic dignitaries and Brethren were present for the Masonic Service. Religious Services were conducted at the First Baptist Church of Fort Thomas on Saturday, February 15, 2014 at

10:00 AM, Rev. Glenn Chasteen officiating. Interment followed at the Persimmon Grove Cemetery, Alexandria, Kentucky.

Brother Tither, the son of Frank Tither and Julia Meyer Tither was born on June 14, 1919, in Cincinnati, Ohio. He received his elementary education in the public school systems in the states of Michigan and Illinois. Brother Tither was self-employed, the owner and operator of Tither Heating and Cooling Company from which he retired several years ago.

Brother Tither proudly served his country in the US Navy during World War II from 1942 to 1945, serving in the Pacific theater of operations. He was in several active engagements during the time.

Brother Tither was of the Baptist faith and a member of the First Baptist Church of Fort Thomas at the time of his passing.

Brother Tither and Billye A. Herald were married on August 1, 1945 and were blessed with two daughters, Kathleen Webber and Kim Margroum, and a son, George W. Tither II (Rusty) who died in infancy.

Grand Master's Message

My father, Brother Ray Wilson Nation, was born on March 17, 1936. Maybe that's why I've always had a special feeling for St. Patrick's Day. Why I always wear green that day and pinch anyone who doesn't. Probably it's because I've always been fascinated by the story of St. Patrick. I'm sure you know at least the basics of the story. St. Patrick drove all the snakes out of Ireland. Maybe it's because I'm terrified of snakes and wish we had a St. Patrick now. But whatever the reason, St. Patrick's Day continues to be very special for me.

You know, snakes often represent evil in literature. In the Bible, Satan assumed the form of a serpent. Maybe I hate snakes because I despise evil. Because I'm trying to improve

myself in Masonry. Because I'm trying to rid myself of my vices and superfluities. Because I'm trying to subdue my passions and circumscribe my desires. For whatever reason, I hate snakes and all they represent.

He was elected and installed as the Most Worshipful Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Kentucky, F. & A. M. at the One Hundredth Ninety Third Annual Communication of the Grand Lodge of Kentucky on October 20, 1992.

Brother Tither served as District Deputy Grand Master of District No. 28 (1977-1978) and on numerous Grand Lodge Committees and appointed offices of the Grand Lodge prior to being elected to the Grand Line. He continued to serve the Grand Lodge of Kentucky on many Grand Lodge Committees and in other capacities, following his term as Grand Master.

Most Worshipful Brother George William Tither was a man of outstanding character and integrity, humble and unassuming; yet standing out as an example of this faith, patriotism, sense of justice and love for his fellowman. His dedication to his God, family, country, fraternity and friends is testimony to his love and devotion to the principles and tenets of the Order, and will be an inspiration to those whom will follow in his footsteps. These richly deserved words regarding Brother Tither were expressed in the report of Most Worshipful Brother Wavne E. Rogers, Chairman of the Committee on Biography as printed in the 1993 Proceedings of the Grand Lodge of Kentucky: "Brother Tither has brought dignity and respect to the Grand Lodge in his every action. 




