

These reunions were big events since many people attended who hadn't seen each other for a long time, and there were always large tables of food set out under the trees in the front vard. On reunion days, Mom and Dad would load my sister's and my bicycles in the back of the pickup along with the food my mother prepared. We would travel to my Grandmother's house and meet other family members who had traveled from far and near. There were al-

ways many children at these reunions and all the relatives had a good time. I am sure

that all of us have at least one extended family member who we counted as a favorite. My favorite was my Great Uncle, Charles William Poynter. Uncle Bill, as we all called him, would always come to the reunions and he was quite a colorful person. He drove nice, big, fancy cars and he always drove fast. My cousins and I were always happy to see our Uncle Bill because he had a very colorful personality and he brought us candy. To us, he was larger than life! When we would see a large dust cloud coming up the gravel road, we knew it had to be him since he always "moved on" when he drove. I distinctly remember one of these reunions since Uncle Bill got there a little late, and we were watching for him. He pulled up into the yard honking the horn for us to move so he would have a place to park. When he opened the door and stepped out of his white, Road Master he had on his jeweled, Shriners Fez. We all loved to look at the Fez and wanted to wear it but he wouldn't let us. Most importantly, when we asked how we could get one he would always say, "You have to be a Mason first." Although I didn't understand at the time, I

now know that Uncle Bill

wanted us to see that Freemasonry, and the Shriners, were very important to him. Since he was a career man at IBM, he almost always wore a blue pair of pants, black shiny shoes, and a long sleeved white dress shirt with the sleeves turned up. That is exactly what he was wearing some forty plus years ago when I saw him get out of that big white car wearing his Fez. I carry this memory, and his words, with me to this day. If not for that very positive exposure to Freemasonry at an early age, I might never have petitioned Woodstock Lodge.

> But when the time came to ask for a petition, I knew that if my Uncle

Bill was a Mason, then I needed to be one also.

My Uncle Bill was a Shrine Mason. He passed away recently but he leaves behind a long legacy of positively impacting the lives of many people. He was a self-made man who assisted with the Shriners Hospital Transportation and was Captain of the Guard for many years. One of the lessons that he taught me is that as a Masonic family of Blue Lodges,

York and Scottish Rites, Shrine, OES and Masonic Youth groups, etc., we need to work together to ensure that our great Fraternity is passed onto the next generation of Freemasons.

Brothers, I applaud you for all the work you are doing in your communities to help people who need it. Those of you who work with school back pack programs, supply shoes or clothing to needy children, donate bicycles to schools for attendance purposes, work with local agencies such as Hospice, help the local food bank for people of all ages, etc., etc., are to be commended. We, as Masons, are taught to do good and charitable works to better our communities and you are doing just that. I want you to continue to be Proud Kentucky Freemasons and remember that the sincere smile and encouraging word that you give to a person may be the only one they will have all day. Please remember that people are watching you and forming an opinion of Freemasonry. Somewhere a child is looking up to you right now, and they will remember how you made them feel for the next forty years.

Until next month, I ask that you continue to be *Proud Kentucky Free Masons!*





Giving through your IRA becomes permanent

Several years ago, Congress passed temporarily a bill allowing individuals to make charitable gifts from their traditional IRAs. Tax legislation signed by the President in December made this provision permanent. Here are the basic details:

- 1. You must be age 70½ or older on the day of the gift.
- 2. You may transfer up to \$100,000 each year per person directly from your traditional IRA to qualified charities like the Homes. You must make a direct transfer of monies to Masonic Homes. If the check comes to you in your name, you may be taxed on it.
- 3. You pay no federal income tax on the gift, but do not get credit for a gift, so you benefit even if you do not itemize your tax deductions.
- 4. The gift can satisfy part or all of the required minimum distribution you must begin receiving each year after reaching age 70½.
- 5. The gift may not be used to fund a gift annuity, charitable remainder trust, donor advised fund or private foundation.
- 6. If a donor made a gift of up to \$100,000 directly from an IRA any time in 2015, the gift will qualify under the new law.

Nominations sought for Board of Directors

The Annual Meeting of Masonic Homes of Kentucky, Inc. will be held on Monday, October 17, 2016. Five Directors will be elected to serve for a three-year term.

To be eligible for election to the office of Director, you must be a Kentucky Master Mason. Directors are expected to attend bi-monthly Board meetings every third Wednesday, serve on assigned committees and perform other duties as assigned by the Chairman of the Board or Executive Committee. Directors serve without remuneration and must own a \$250 Life Membership to Masonic Homes of Kentucky, Inc. Members are also encouraged to make a contribution to the Homes' Masonicare program each year of their service.

To be considered for nomination to the Board of Directors, you must submit a current resume including: name, address, current occupation, phone number, education and work experience, previous board experience, organizational offices held, references and Masonic affiliation and history. The resume may be submitted on regular stationery, mailed with a recent photograph, and postmarked no later than July 1, 2016.




