## ROAD READY

Driving in winter weather can be dangerous and surprising. Make sure you're ready for unexpected repairs or delays by keeping a well-stocked emergency kit with the following items in your vehicle. Even in warmer months, the kit can be useful if you're stranded.


IF YOU BECOME STRANDED

- DO NOT leave your vehicle. Only leave if you know exactly where you're located, how far away you are rrom assistance and if youre certain - Light two flares to attract attention, placing one a safe distance from each end of your vehicle.

Use gloves and blankets to keep your
extremities warm. These items should extremities warm. These items should
be part of your emergency kit (above) be part of your emergency kit (above),
You can also indude hand warmers, available at most sporting goods stores. When the warmer is crushed or twisted a chemical reaction occurs to create heat.

- Hard candy may seem like an unusual item for your emergency kit, but eating it will keep your
mouth moist.

Ensure your vehicle's exhaust pipe is not
blocked and run the engine and heater for blocked and run the engine and heater for
10 -minute intervals each hour, depending on how much gas is in your tank.

- Keep at least one window slightly open. Heany snow and ice can seal a vehicle shut.


## Winter Weather Tips

for your four-legged friends!
It's a common belief that dogs and cats are resistant than people to cold weather because of theirf fur, but it's untrue. Like people, cats and dogs are susceptible to frostbite and hypothermia.

## Keep Pets Inside

Longer-haired and thick-coated dog breeds, such as huskies and other dogs bred for colder climates, are more tolerant of cold weather, but no pet should be left outside for long periods of time in below-freezing weather.

Provide Choices
Just like you, pets prefer comfortable sleeping places and may change their location based on their need for more or less warmth. Give them some safe options to allow them to vary their sleeping place to adjust to their needs.

Make Some NOIsE!
A warm vehicle engine can be an appealing heat source for outdoor and feral cats, but it's deadly. Check undemeath your car, bang on the hood, and honk the hom before starting the engine to encourage feline hitchhikers to abandon their roost under the hood.

Play Dress Up!
If your dog has a short coat or seems bothered by the cold weather, consider a sweater or dog coat. Have several on hand, so you can use a dry sweater or coat each time your dog goes outside. Wet sweaters or coats can actually make your dog colder. Some pet owners also use booties to protect their dog's feet; if you choose to use them, make sure they fit properly.

## Provide Shelter

We don't recommend keeping any pet outside for long periods of time, but if you are unable to keep your dog inside during cold weather, provide them with a warm, dry, solid shelter against wind. If you're able to, consider providing shelters for stray cats in the neighborhood.

## 6. Be Prepared

Cold weather also brings the risks of severe winter weather, blizzards and power outages. Prepare a disaster/emergency kit, and include your pet in your plans. Have enough food, water and medicine (including any prescription medications as well as heartworm and flea/tick preventives) on hand to get through at least 5 days.

Add Light Dimmers \& Occupancy Sensors for a $\mathbf{2 0 \%}$ or more savings on lighting costs.

Using your fireplace instead of a traditional
heater can save you up to $50 \%$ on your heating costs.

Cleaning or replacing your furnace's filter twice a year can slash your heating costs by


Reverse your ceiling fans in the winter to recirculate trapped heat by the ceiling and save up to $10 \%$.

Save up to $10 \%$ off your energy bill by removing solar panels or sun blocking curtains.

Set your heater to $68^{\circ}$ when you're home \& $55^{\circ}$ when you're gone to cut your energy costs by up to $20 \%$.

Save \$1000s on your energy costs by installing the right Energy Star rated furnace, a geothermal heating pump or broilers with an electric ignition.
