KENTUCKY DEMOLAY HOLDS SPRING CONCLAVE AT LAKE CUMBERLAND STATE PARK





THE KNIGHTS TEMPLAR

My Brothers, you may have heard, seen or read about the Knights Templar, but just who are they, and how does one become a member?

Well first things first. The Knights Templar were formed in the year 1118 as a crusading order mainly to engage in escorting pilgrims to the Holy Land. They became and remained immensely powerful until their sudden and dramatic official end in 1307-1314.

Our current Knights Templar are part of the Fraternity of Freemasons, the oldest and largest fraternal organization in the world. And while the Masonic Lodge and its degrees are fundamental and central to all of Freemasonry, many desire to enhance that experience by becoming a Knight Templar. Templars are part of the system known as the York Rite of Freemasonry. And membership is limited to those who profess a faith in Christianity and who are also members of a Masonic Lodge, a Capitular Chapter, a Cryptic Council and of course a Templar Commandery.

All members belong to a local Commandery, which is then governed by a Grand Commandery, which in turn is operated under the Grand Encampment of the United

States of America. More than 20 countries boast membership in the Grand Encampment, which makes it truly a worldwide fraternal organization.

The lessons taught within the Commanderies are called Orders, or which there are three. The Order of the Red Cross, the Order of Malta and the Order of the Temple.



The Order of the Red Cross predates the era of the crusades. In this order the candidate represents Zerubbabel, whose wisdom in a friendly contest was rewarded by King Darius, and enabled Zerubbabel to re-

> turn to Jerusalem to rebuild the temple which had been destroyed by King Nebuchadnezzar. The very temple which you symbolically worked on during the Legend of the Temple in the Master Mason Degree.

> The Order of Malta relates the story of St. Paul's arrival on the island of Melita, (which is now known as Malta). In this Order, which is the first of the Christian Orders contained in the Chivalric system, is explained the periods of the Order's history, and the history of the Knights of St. John, (Knights of Malta) which are paralleled with the birth, life, death, resurrection and ascension of our Savior Jesus Christ.

> And lastly the Order of the Temple, which many consider the most beautiful in the series. During this ceremony the candidate represents a knight of the era that succeeded the crusades and vowed to visit the Holy Sepulcher. After undergoing seven years of penance and trials, is at last made a knight and received into the Order in a most

solemn and impressive manner.

My Brethren, every Mason needs, and should want the knowledge that is explained in the Chapter and Council Degrees. And every Christian Mason should seek membership in a Commandery of Knights Templar, and thus become a Masonic Knight of Christ.

"I Didn't Know That....."

"I will Strive to Live with Love and Care, Upon the Levl by the Square - 1507". This phrase was found inscribed upon a corroded brass square, and underneath the foundation stone of an ancient bridge near Limerick Ireland. Today, these words have the same meaning to every Mason, as they did to that stone mason who placed it there, 512 years ago.

The well-known author and Freemason Rudyard Kipling while in living in India once wrote; "We met upon the level and parted upon the square, I was Jr. Deacon in my Mother Lodge out there." His poem "The Mother Lodge" also noted that his Lodge in India, consisted of brethren of all walks of life and all Religions including Catholic, Protestant, Jewish, Sikh and Muslim brothers.



The Reverend Joseph Fort Newton author of many Masonic books, including his classic "The Builders" relates a story found in an old book in China, believed to be written 500 years before Christ, that a man should not do unto others what he would not have them do unto him; adding "This is called the principle of acting upon the square." Today we read in the New Testament, basically the same "Golden Rule".

As a Kentucky Mason, the first thing you saw upon entering a Lodge, on the altar was the Holy Bible, Square and Compasses, with the Master standing behind the altar wearing the jewel of his office, a square. All throughout the Masonic ceremonies, you were reminded of the beautiful lessons of the square. But Masonry is more than Ritual. It is a way of life! As one Brother relates, "every Mason is obligated to be on the square in his dealings with others, and that our thoughts, words and actions should be good, true and square". May I sum it up with the words of an unknown poet written many years ago?

HERE SLEEPETH NOW A FELLOW WHO WAS ALWAYS ON THE SQUARE

It matters not whate'er your lot or what your task may be One duty there remains for you, one duty stands for me. Be you a doctor skilled and wise, or do your work for wage, A laborer upon the street, an artist on the stage; One glory still awaits you, one honor that is fair, To have men say as you walk by, "That fellow's on the square."

Ah, here's a phrase that stands for much, t'is good old English too; It means that men have confidence in everything you do It means that what you have you've earned, and that you've done your best,

And when you go to sleep at night untroubled you may rest. It means that conscience is your guide, and honor is your care; There is no greater praise then this: "That fellow's on the square".

And when I die I would not wish a lengthy epitaph; I do not want a headstone large, carved with fulsome chaff. Pick out no single deed of mine, if such a deed there be, To 'grave upon my monument, for everyone to see. Just one phrase for all I choose, to show my life was fair: "Here sleepeth now a fellow who was always on the square"


